This means that no one should be excluded from employment or academic opportunities because of their race, religion, gender, disability, age, social or economic class, or pregnancy and maternity.

The President will ensure that all rules and regulations are consistent with the policy, allocate adequate budget and set up the necessary administrative infrastructure, and establish a robust monitoring mechanism to find the extent to which the policy is being followed.
